know him that he was appointed by the Harper government to the Federal Court, the Federal Court of Appeal, and now the Quebec Court of Appeal. Some people are simply respected for what they have accomplished and who they are. Judge Mainville is one of those.

As for an eventual appointment to the Supreme Court of Canada, I have no idea of how that process is carried out. All I know is that few aboriginal lawyers and non-aboriginals who have defended First Nations have been appointed to the courts in general, and none to the Supreme Court of Canada. Should Judge Mainville be some day appointed to the highest court in Canada, I for one would applaud this.
